At Home: Reading to your child daily and allowing them the opportunity to practice reading will help them immensely this year! You can also work on writing their first and last name, reviewing letter names/sounds, and reviewing their numbers (counting and the names of numbers). If you would like a set of alphabet cards please let me know and will send those home. *There will be a kindergarten skill sheet coming home next week in the back of your child's folder. Please **DO NOT** mark on this or take it out of their folder. However, you can reference it to review their kindergarten skills.

We are going to begin learning our colors next week! Each week will be a new color. One of the things I am planning on doing, is creating a color wall in the classroom. This is something that I did when I was in kindergarten and I also did it last year when teaching preschool! As we learn a new color, we will add that color to the wall. I am asking that your child either draw/color a picture, print off a picture, or bring in a picture of something that is the color we are learning. I will update you through Bloomz and my website of the color we will be learning about the following week. Next week the first color we are going to learn is red. I hope your child can participate and help bring some color to the classroom!

If you have not already done so, please make sure that you are signed up for our class notifications through Bloomz. This is the fastest way for me to get ahold of you if there is a quick question, notify you of schedule changes, and reminders of upcoming dates. I ask that you sign up no later than Friday, September 6. The code to join is BZBYTX.
