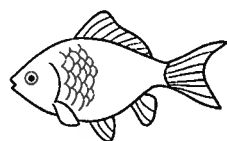
Dear Parents/Guardians,

We have been working hard to learn letters and their sounds. Each week in Language Arts, your child learns a new letter and the sound(s) it makes. If you would like a set of alphabet flashcards to practice at home, please let me know and I will send them home with your child. We have also been learning our colors and practicing songs to help us spell the color words. During reading groups we are learning how to use the pictures to help us figure out what the sentences might be telling us as well as learning to sound out words with the phonics skills we are learning in reading class with Miss Smith.

In an effort to keep up communication between home and school/clubhouse.
